NOTICE REGARDING MEMBER ELECTION ELIGIBILITY
IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ

This Notice is a reminder that both the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Constitution and Local 50 By-Laws require All Members To Attend At Least Fifty Percent (50%) Of The Regular Memberships Meetings During The Twenty-Four (24) Consecutive Month Period Prior To Nominations To Be Eligible To Run For Office. Local 50 has posted this notice in meeting hall, with additional copies, in order to make sure all members are aware of this important eligibility requirement.

This requirement is located in both the IBT Constitution at Article II, Section 4(a)(2) and the Local 50 By-Laws at Section 17 (c)(3), as follows:

"...a member must have attended at least fifty (50%) percent of the regular or divisional meetings of this Local Union during the regular twenty-four (24) consecutive months prior to nominations in order to be eligible to run for office."

Verification of attendance is contingent upon your signing the attendance book at each membership meeting.
